

Folly Fellowship visit to the follies of Worlitz and Potsdam, Germany

Saturday and Sunday September 9<sup>th</sup> and 10<sup>th</sup> 2017

This trip will be based in Dessau, about one hour south of Berlin by train. This is a 'pay as you go' trip and you make your own travel and accommodation arrangements, and pay entry fees. There is a charge of £15.00 per person to cover administration charges only.

The park at Worlitz is the centre of the 'Garden Kingdom', a succession of parks, palaces and garden buildings stretching 10km along the valley of the Elbe. Worlitz contains a number of striking buildings including the Gothic House, the Pantheon, the Villa Hamilton, and the Stein, an artificial volcano and we will spend Saturday touring the grounds.

On Sunday we go to Potsdam, to Sanssouci to see the Dragon House, the Chinese Teahouse, The Orangery, the Antique Temple, The Roman Baths, and the Belvedere.

If you have a few more days to spend there are other follies to visit around Dessau and Potsdam. In addition Dessau is the home of the Bauhaus, which can be visited, and there a number of Bauhaus era buildings around the town.
